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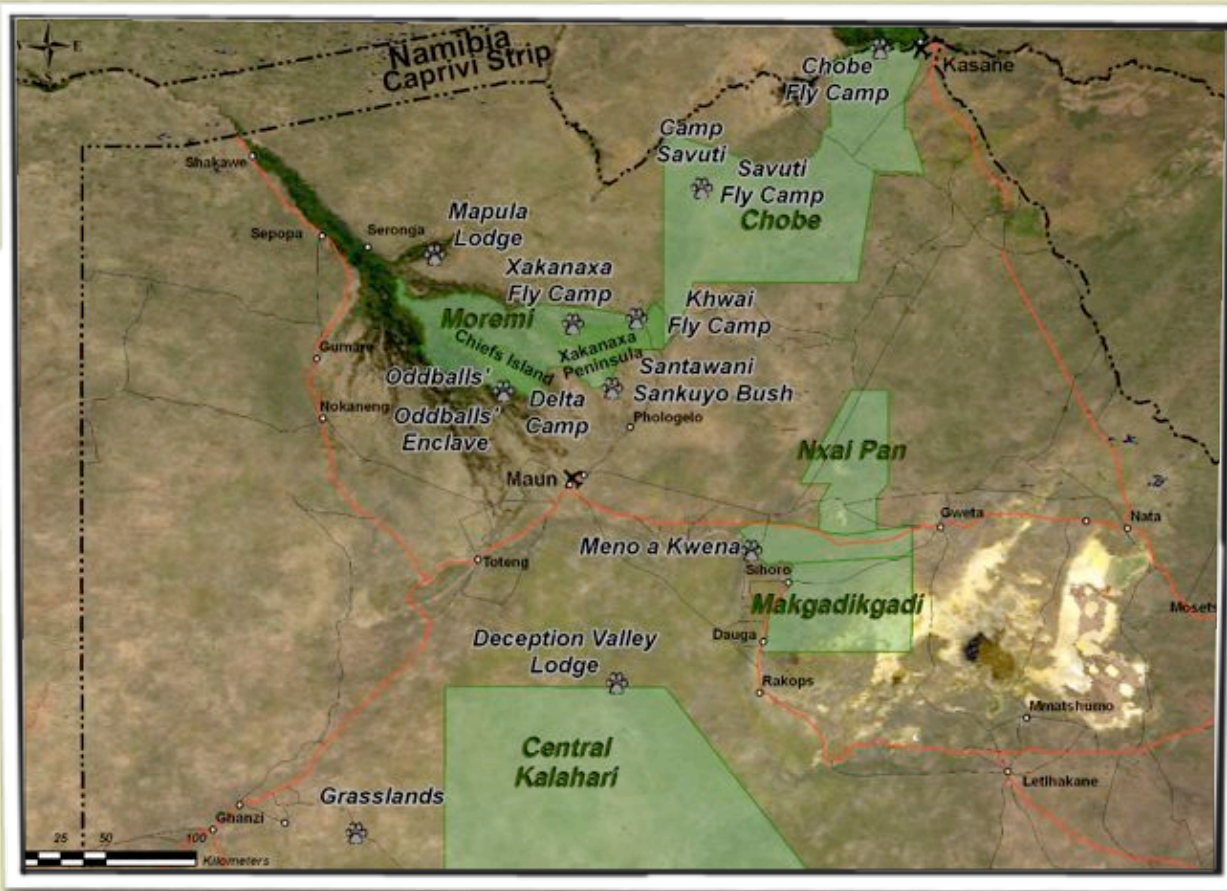

MENO A KWENA

The Boteti Riverbed forms the western boundary of the Makgadikgadi Pans National Park in North Central Botswana.

Meno a Kwena is the name given to a deep stretch of the Boteti River once inhabited by hippos and crocodiles. The name, Meno a Kwena translated from Setswana means “Teeth of the Crocodile”

Accommodation consists of eight fully-serviced meru walk-in tents with semi-attached bathrooms including a bucket shower and flush toilet.

Enjoy the view from your tent while hearing the

sounds of the wild beckoning you to return once again to Africa.

The main complex tent, comprises the lounge and dining area, library, bar and kitchen, from where delicious traditional safari meals are prepared.

All Meals are cooked on the campfire by the in-house chef, and prepared specially for the BBQ and ‘tin box oven’, adding to our guests’ authentic safari experience.

Canvas shelter viewing areas around the ‘natural’ rock pool offer a unique vantage point above the riverbed, an ‘up close’ viewing hide brings guests closer to the wildlife activity.

The area is home to southern Africa's largest wildebeest and zebra migration, all species of African predators including brown hyaena, meerkats, - perhaps the most diverse natural wildlife habitats in southern Africa, all within reach of Meno a Kwena Tented Camp!

The salt pans are a fascinating source of archaeological and historic relics in and around what was once the bed of a vast inland lake. We offer optional salt pans experience safaris that include a quad bike trip into the middle of the salt pan to sleep out in a camp set up in advance under a canopy of stars.

You can combine any of our camps and lodges with Meno a Kwena, however some might combine better than others as they are “more” similar in terms of pricing and experience.

They are:

Oddballs Enclave - Chief's Island Area - walking and mokoro.

Grasslands Bushman Lodge - Western side of Central Kalahari Game Reserve - game drives, bushman activities, horseback safaris and a predator rehabilitation centre
